ORDINANCE NO. 11-04-R

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 184 AND
CHAPTER 253 OF THE BOROUGH CODE OF FANWOOD
TO REVISE THE SCHEDULE OF FEES**

BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Fanwood, County of Union, State of New Jersey, as follows:

Section I. Section 184-36 of the Borough Code is amended as follows:

“U. SIGNS: One Hundred (\$100) Dollars for each commercial sign.”

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“W. Shed: Fifty (\$50) Dollars for each shed under one hundred (100’) square feet.

“X. Fences: Thirty Five (\$35) Dollars.”

Section II. Section 184-163G of the Borough Code is amended as follows:

“G. A zoning permit shall be required to construct or expand a driveway for a permitted principal residential use in the R-75 and R-150 zones. The applicant shall pay a fee of Twenty-Five (\$25) Dollars to the Borough for a permit to resurface the driveway without an expansion of the driveway and a fee of Fifty (\$50) Dollars for a permit to reconstruct or expand a driveway.”

Section III. Section 253-4 of the Borough Code is amended as follows:

“C. In addition to submitting the applications referred to in Subsections A and B above, each application shall be accompanied in the case of an original application for a period of time (i) no greater than thirty (30) days with payment of a fee to the Borough of \$25, (ii) no greater than sixty (60) days with payment of a fee to the Borough of \$50, and (iii) in the case of an extension application of greater than sixty (60) days with payment of a fee to the Borough of \$100. The fees in question will cover the administrative costs of the Borough, as well as oversight to make certain that the applicant performs in accordance with its application, including but not limited to the removal of the container at the expiration of the permit.”

Section IV. All ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistency.

Section V. If any portion of this ordinance shall be determined to be invalid, such determination shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions of said ordinance.

Section VI. This ordinance shall take effect upon second reading and final passage and publication in accordance with law. A copy of this ordinance shall be sent to the Union County Planning Board.
