

What is a Master Plan?

- Policy document that:
 - outlines a vision for future development; and,
 - includes information, goals and strategies to achieve vision.
- Comprised of various master plan elements covering specific topics.
- Required elements:
 - Land Use Element; and,
 - Statement of Goals and Objectives.
- Adopted by municipal planning board.
- Master plans must be reexamined every 10 years.



Fanwood's Master Plan

- Current Fanwood Master Plan was:
 - o originally adopted in November 1998; and,
 - last reexamined in 2021.
- Current Fanwood Master Plan contains:
 - Statement of Goals and Objectives;
 - Land Use Element;
 - Historic Preservation Plan Element
 - Community Facilities Plan Element;
 - Utilities Plan Element;
 - Open Space and Recreation Plan Element;
 - Circulation Element;
 - Housing Element and Fair Share Plan;
 - Recycling Plan Element.







Fanwood's Master Plan Update

- T&M is currently preparing an updated master plan for the Borough.
- Updated Fanwood Master Plan to contain:
 - Statement of Goals and Objectives;
 - Land Use Element with Climate Change-Related Hazard Vulnerability Assessment;
 - Green Buildings and Environmental Sustainability Element;
 - Historic Preservation Plan Element;
 - Statement of Plan Relationships.
 - Community Facilities Plan Element;
 - Utilities Plan Element;
 - Open Space and Recreation Plan Element;
 - Circulation Element;
 - Housing Plan Element (incorporates 2017 Housing Element and Fair Share Plan);
 - Recycling Plan Element.












Fanwood is challenged by ...


Roadway Congestion	Development Pressures
